George Lowther Steer was born 22 November 1909 and died 25 December 1944. This year sees his 110th birthday and 75th anniversary of his death.

George Steer wrote the explosive report in 'The Times' on the bombing of Guernica that shocked the British public and led to the British Government's acceptance of the arrival of the *SS Habana* to Southampton with its cargo of Basque child refugees.
