Mr Otto was a general handyman who also mended shoes.

Srta Amada (who later married Theo Wills) was the main organiser of the dance group and she played the piano for the songs and dances. She was also a good and cultures teacher.

Other teachers were Srta Celia Echaverria, Srta Peque (Cecilia Gurich), Srta Berta, Srta Deme and Srta Rafaela Collado (helper)
